- Financial modeling to assess financial and economic viability, calculating financial indicators as well as other key performance indicators relevant to public and private sector-funded projects
- Technical writing for different kinds of audiences, incl. other experts, donors and the public at large
- Contributions to academic research activities and programs (e.g. E-Learning course and Summer Academy)
- Project management, reporting, coordination of external experts, and business development

Qualifications

- University degree in finance, banking, economics or public policy
- At least 5 years of relevant work experience for senior climate finance experts, experience in emerging markets is a plus
- Knowledge of either renewable energy, energy efficiency or climate adaptation, combined with an understanding of corporate and/or project finance
- Genuine interest in unbiased qualitative and quantitative analysis and economically justifiable regulation and programs to promote private sector activity in climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Excellent quantitative and qualitative analytical skills; ability to conduct in-depth research; strong writing skills
- Independent thinker with pragmatic problem solving skills; proactive attitude on assignments/projects
- Strong communication skills within and outside the team, commitment, sociability, flexibility, intercultural sensitivity
- Fluent in English and either French or Spanish, both oral and in writing
- Proficiency in MS Office, incl. financial modeling experience in Excel, and advanced Word and PowerPoint skills
